Scotty came from a musical family and was starting to lay the ground work for his music by age 8 by playing banjo, guitar, and singing. By age 15 he was playing in local bands around the state of Missouri. When Scotty was 17 his love for pedal steel guitar began. Foregoing a scholarship he decided, after high school, to take a full time playing job in the Oklahoma panhandle. While there he wrote two instructional books for steel guitar, played on various recording sessions and played five nights a week. After a short time on the road he moved to Hutchinson, Kansas and worked around the Wichita area playing and recording. In 2003 he moved to Lake of the Ozarks and performed at the famous Lee Mace's Ozark Opry for two seasons. In 2005 he was inducted into the Kansas Steel Guitar Hall of Fame and 2010 was inducted into the WSMSS Western Swing Hall of Fame. Over the last 30 years Scotty has performed with some of the greats! Charlie Daniels, Wanda Jackson, Hank Thompson, Jack Green, Jeannie Seely, Narvel Felts, Leona Williams, and many others. Scotty is a multi instrumentalist who plays steel guitar, fiddle, mandolin, banjo, lead guitar. Of course steel guitar is his passion. It's been a great ride with many good musical memories and friendships.
